All fittings or fixtures installed before January 4, 2014 are exempt from the requirements contained within the Reduction of Lead in Drinking Water Act.

### So why make the change now?

In preparation of the nationwide change, Zurn has already begun the transition to lead-free material.

We are transitioning in advance of the deadline mandated by pending legislation because we are interested in minimizing the risk for all parties who will be affected by this change.


